Illness

Sick & diarrhoea – children must stay off nursery/school for 48 hours after the last time they were sick or had diarrhoea

Head lice – please keep checking your child's hair on a regular basis and treat straight away.

Worms – if found, children should be treated before coming back to nursery/school. To help stop the spread of the threadworms please can you encourage your child to wash their hands after going to the toilet.

Please inform staff if your child has head lice or threadworms so we can make other parents aware that they are around in the Unit.
