Can we remind you about the following –

## Illness



**Sick & diarrhoea** – children must stay off nursery/school for 48 hours after the last time they were sick or had diarrhoea

**Head lice** – please keep checking your child's hair on a regular basis and treat straight away. Please can you also treat all members of the family as well.

Please inform staff if your child has head lice so we can make other parents aware that they are around in the Unit.

**Uniform** - Please, please, please can you mark all your children's clothes with their names. After every PE lesson we have various items of clothes floating around the rooms with no names on. **Coats** also need to have the child's name in – lots of children have the same coat!!!!!!  
**Please can you also check their clothes when they get home and if they are not your child's could you send them back to school.**



## Jewellery

Jewellery should not be worn for PE lessons which are on Monday & Thursday for both classes. If ear rings are worn on these days, they should be taped up.



### Coats & Wellingtons

As we play out in all weathers, children should have a coat in school every day due to the ever changing weather. Has your child a pair of Wellingtons in school? They are very useful on a wet, muddy day. **Please put your child's name on them with a permanent marker**

### Wanted
