P.E.

This term we will be doing Gymnastics and Dance on Mondays and Wednesdays, this will be in preparation for our 1990's concert on the 14th April 2011. The children are expected to bring their PE kits into school at the beginning of each half term, taking them home every holiday to be washed. Please ensure every part of your child's uniform is clearly labelled. Maths- In our maths lessons we will be looking at shape and space and beginning to look at algebra, alongside the basic addition,

subtraction, multiplication and division work.

Literacy- This term our units of work include: Biographies and Auto-biographies, and Narrative flashbacks. All of this work will be linked to our topic work.

Homework will continue as of last term, Learning Logs will be handed out on a Wednesday and will be due back on Monday. Please encourage your child to read often (sometimes aloud) and practise mental maths calculations regularly (especially times tables).
