*Once again this is a very busy & important half term particularly for Year 2 children as they prepare for their SATs at the beginning of May. Let's begin by looking at our curriculum study areas.*

**Science:** Begins with topic "Pushes & Pulls", followed by sorting and using materials.

**In ITC:** We shall be looking at Text & Graphics.

**Literacy:** Now this is going to be really Exciting—there will be stories about "Fantasy Worlds"  
Recount (fact & fiction).

**Maths:** The children will be focusing on a variety of areas including recognising odd and even numbers, mentally adding or subtracting 1 digit numbers and recognising number bonds.
